On Wednesday, January 22, 2020, Anita Pease, the Director of the US EPA Antimicrobial Division announced that the Washington State case of the Wuhan Coronavirus has triggered the EPA emerging pathogen policy (<https://www.epa.gov/pesticide-registration/emerging-viral-pathogen-guidance-antimicrobial-pesticides>).
